Whereas, respondent No.3 has freezed the amount. Such that the petitioner is unable to operate account. Further, the petitioner is facing problem in providing treatment to his six</p>	

months old child who is hospitalized.

In the circumstances, respondent No.3 is directed to unfreeze the petitioner's account bearing No.9230100020971989 and to restore full operational access to the petitioner barring the disputed amount of Rs.52,700/-.
